Teaching Suggestions:

- Around a circle, ask children what vegetable (or fruit) they are going to put in the pot. That child can then clap the name of the vegetable and figure out how many syllables it has. (This is great preparation work for teaching rhythm!)
- Around the circle, children suggest a vegetable to put in the pot and that then becomes part of a list of vegetables. E.g. Child 1 'carrot'; child 2 'carrot and potato'; child 3 'carrot, potato and onion'. (This develops memory which is an integral part of any dictation work!)

N.B. The children can either think of vegetables OR you can have pictures of vegetables they can name.
