SUGGESTED GAME:

Formation: Everyone sitting in a circle.

Game: 1. Pass a black sock (or a picture of one) around the circle on the beat.

2. On the last word of the song, the person holding the sock walks as fast as they can anticlockwise around the circle back to their spot. AT THE SAME TIME, the person who was to their left, walks clockwise around the circle back to their spot.
3. The first person back wins and gets to start passing the sock as the game begins again.

Variation: At the end of the song, instead of singing 'not yet' three times, the teacher (or a chosen student) can lead the class in singing 'not yet' as many times as they like. The chosen student can be the one who makes it back to their spot the previous time.
