'Boggo Road' - In Brisbane, Queensland, this was one of Australia's most notorious prisons.

'Broad Arrows' - Prisoners wore white shirts and pants with big black arrows on them.

'Branded' - To 'brand' an animal is to put your 'mark' on it. (Usually by holding a red-hot metal branding

tool against the animals rump) so everyone knew who owned the animal.

'Clean skin' - an animal without a brand.

'Things are pretty crook' - life is quite tough.
